True Blue Boarding Scholarship

Description

The True Blue Merit Scholarship (\$10,000) recognizes up to two current day students entering grades 8 - 11 who wish to develop their leadership and independence by living on campus as members of our boarding community. Named for our school color, these awards will be given to students who exemplify the Garrison Forest spirit. These awards will follow recipients as long as they are boarding students at Garrison Forest.

Application Process

Applicants should complete the True Blue Scholarship Essay by **January 28, 2022**. The essay must be written by the student, and should be sent to Catie Gibbons by email at catiegibbons@gfs.org. Finalists will be invited to interview with Jodi Blackburn, Director of Residential Life in early February, and applications will be reviewed by the True Blue Scholarship Committee..
